



MOODLE is the College’s new Virtual Learning Environment, or **VLE**.

Moodle contains lots of small web sites, called ‘courses’. A handful of these ‘courses’ are available to everyone, e.g. **Key Skills @ HRC** and **Microsoft Office 2007**, however, most of them are dedicated to individual courses taught at HRC.

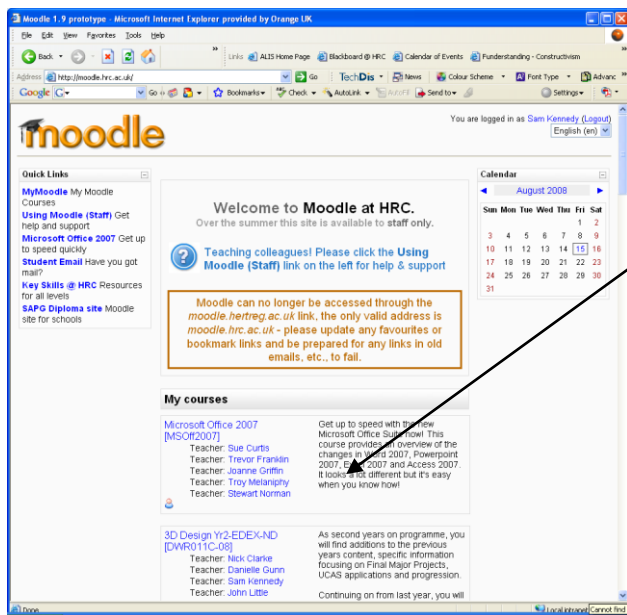
If your course has an active Moodle ‘course’, your tutor will upload useful information and documents to it, such as lesson handouts, assignment briefs and web links. You can access your Moodle courses anytime, anywhere, on any Internet enabled PC.

Accessing Moodle



You can access Moodle from your **StudentNet** homepage by clicking on the Moodle icon. If you do it this way, you’ll be logged into Moodle automatically.

If you want to access Moodle directly, type the following address into the address line of Internet Explorer* and log in with your network username and password: **http://moodle.hrc.ac.uk**



Once you are logged onto Moodle you will see your Moodle courses displayed at the bottom of the page under **My Courses**.
Click the title of the course to access it.

Your course tutors will explain how they expect you to use Moodle.
